

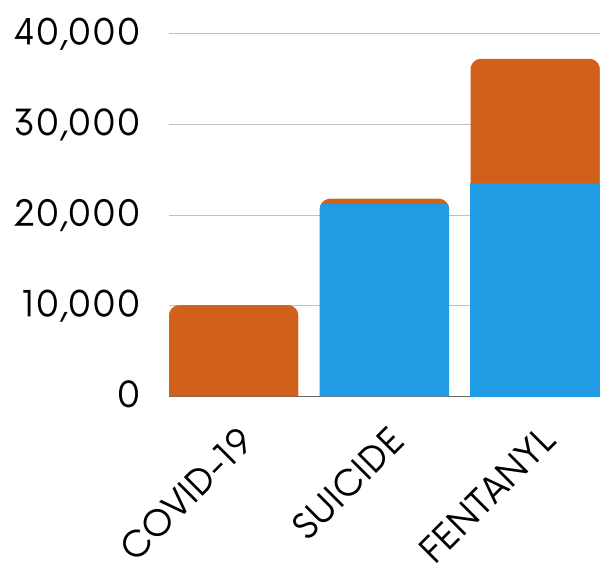
FENTANYL FATALITIES

FENTANYL POISONING POSES A SERIOUS THREAT TO THE AMERICAN PUBLIC, KILLING MORE PEOPLE LAST YEAR THAN SUICIDE, CAR ACCIDENTS, OR GUN VIOLENCE.

POINT 1

Fentanyl is now the #1 cause of death for Americans age 18 to 45.

1. **FENTANYL POISONING**
2. SUICIDE
3. COVID-19
4. CAR ACCIDENTS

Drug "overdose" deaths reached record high

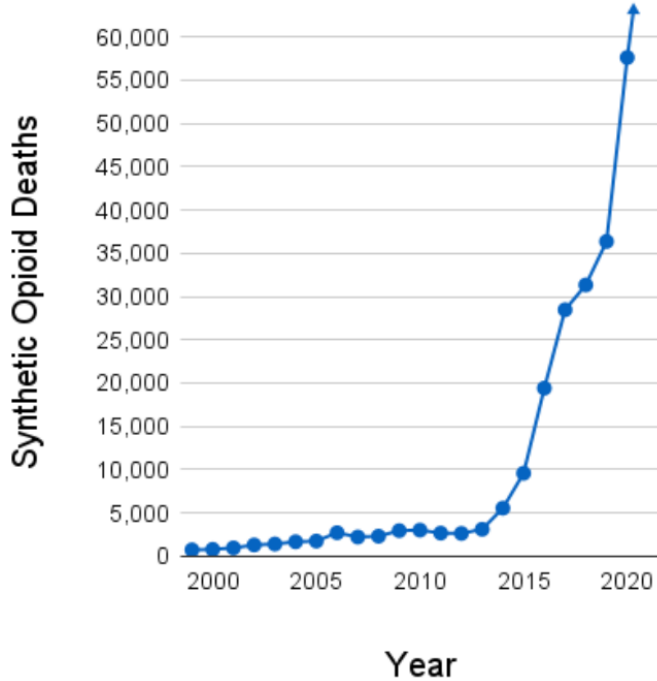

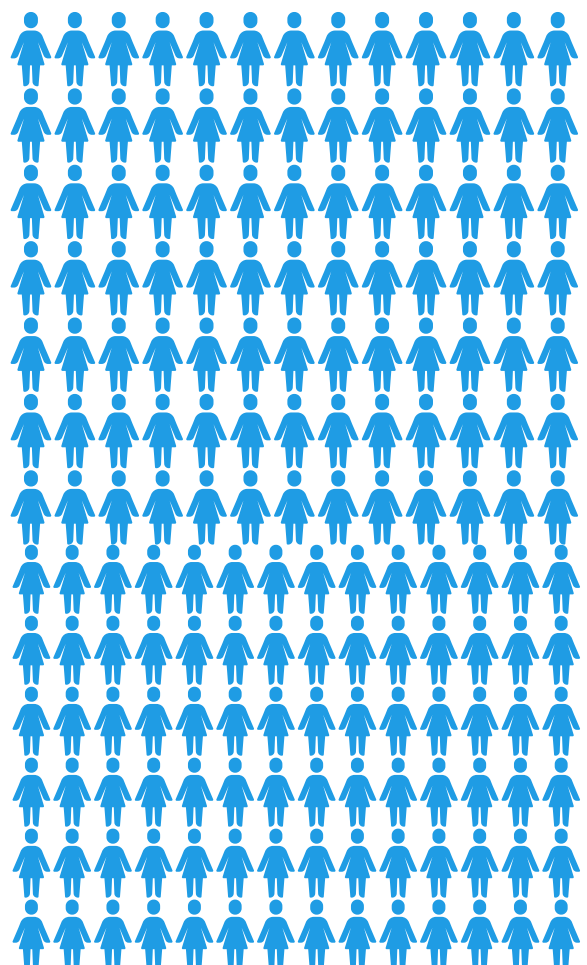

175 people die from fentanyl poisoning every day in the U.S.

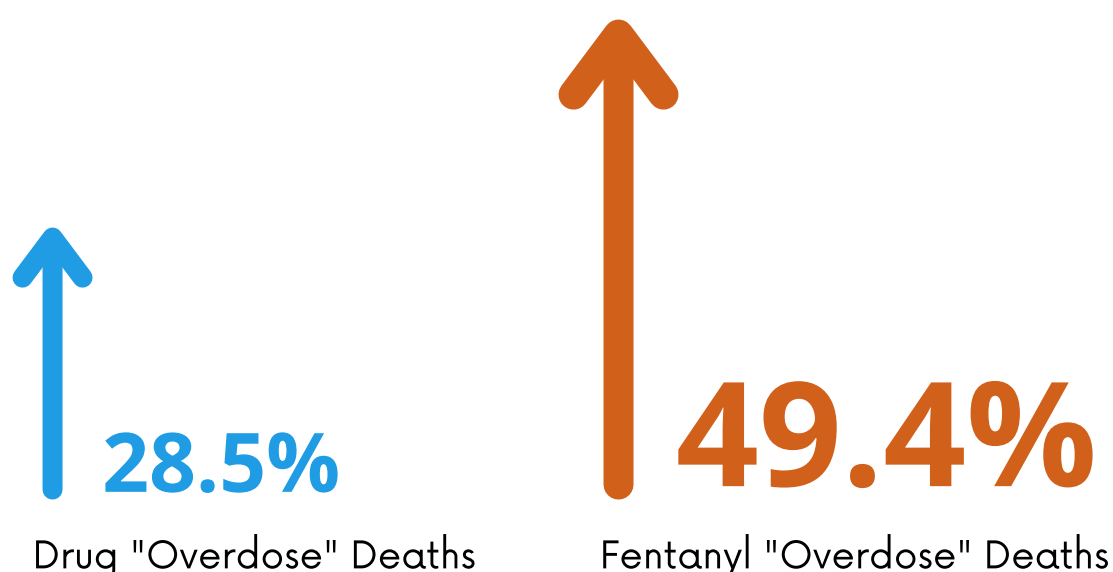


The chart above highlights the sharp increase of fentanyl related deaths over the past years

POINT 4

Fentanyl related deaths have increased by 49.4% in just 12 months, surpassing 64k deaths as of April 2021.

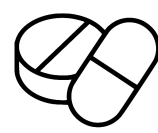
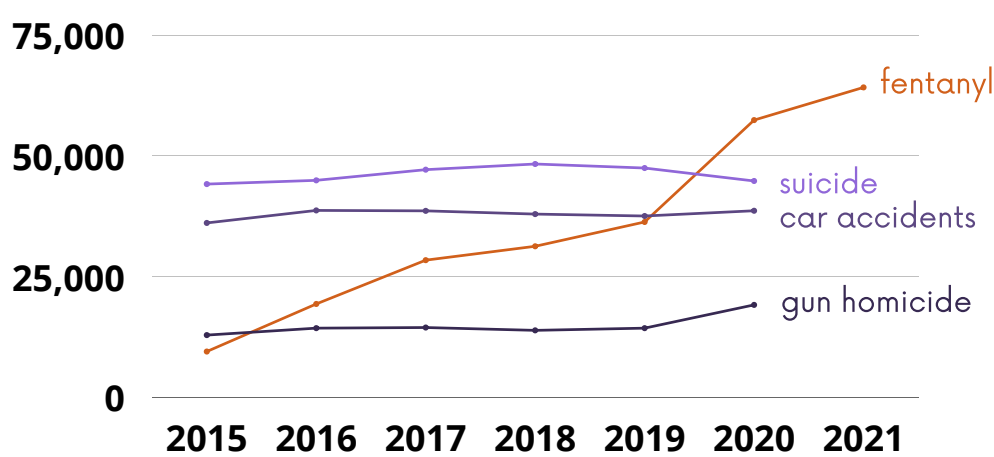


POINT 5 & 6

Fentanyl is tied to **64%** of drug "overdoses."

Fentanyl is laced into cocaine, heroin, ecstasy, xanax, oxycontin & marijuana sold on the streets

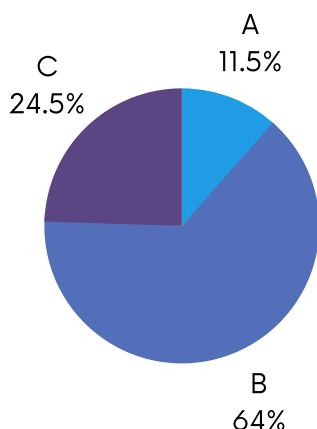
A Comparison of Fentanyl Fatalities in the U.S



This chart illustrates the overall change in the leading causes of death by year.

The chart on the right breaks down the total number of drug deaths this past year by drug type

B ~ fentanyl, C ~ opioids other than fentanyl, A ~ all other drugs



Illicit fentanyl is shipped into the U.S. and then cut into many street drugs and sold to unsuspecting Americans
